The Transfer Station facility is open to East Millinocket Property
Owners or their designee ONLY.

This form must be completed prior to disposal of acceptable building or demolition debris, in any form, at the East Millinocket Transfer Station.

The following conditions shall be met in order to dispose of any demolition type materials at the East Millinocket Transfer Station. The load will be checked before dumping and will be turned away if the following conditions are not met:

- All wood material will be free of insulation, shingles, metal, etc.
- All metal will be free of wood, siding, insulation, etc.
- Pressure treated lumber must be separated.
- All fuel tanks and 55 gallon barrels must be cut in half and free of any fuel, oil or other petroleum type materials.
- NO ACM (Asbestos Containing Material) will be accepted.

The Debris permit must be signed by the code enforcement officer before any debris is brought to the Transfer Station. The load must pass inspection based on the above stated debris disposal conditions. This is determined by the Transfer Station attendant. If the conditions for dumping debris are not followed the load(s) will not be accepted.

# TOWN OF EAST MILLINOCKET TRANSFER STATION RECYCLABLES & ACCEPTED MATERIALS

### FEES FOR TIRES AND SHINGLES

- Tires up to a 16" rim size are \$2.00 each. Rims must be removed from tires before disposal.
- Tires over a 16" rim size up to a 20" rim size are \$4.00 each. Rims must be removed from tires before disposal.
- Tires over a 20" diameter rim size are prohibited.
- Shingles will be charged at a rate of \$50.00 per pickup load.
   Trailers that are of the same equivalent will be charged the same.
   Excessive loads will be charged accordingly by the operator of the Transfer Station.
- All fuel tanks and 55 gallon barrels must be cut in half and cleaned.

ACM (Asbestos Containing Material)
WILL NOT be accepted at the East Millinocket Transfer Station.

#### THE ITEMS WE CURRENTLY RECYCLE ARE LISTED BELOW:

- (ONP) Old Newspaper (OMG) Old Magazines: Newspapers, Magazines, Telephone Directories, Catalogs, Office Paper and Junk Mail.
   (THIS MATERIAL DOES NOT NEED TO BE SEPARATED).
- (OCC) OLD CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: Cardboard Boxes.
   (NO WAXED CARDBOARD).
- Mixed Paper: Brown Grocery and Potato Bags, Shirt, Cereal, Cracker, Shoe,
   Pizza and Dry Food Boxes, Egg Cartons and boxes that toys are sold in.
   (THIS MATERIAL CAN BE MIXED WITH CARDBOARD).

#### ALL PLASTIC, GLASS, AND TIN CONTAINERS MUST BE DRAINED AND CLEANED

- Plastics: <u>Colored Bottles</u> with Recycle #2 on the bottom such as: Laundry, Bleach, Cleaning Detergent, Anti-Freeze and Oil Jugs, Shampoo, Dish Soap, Aspirin, Tylenol, and Vitamin Bottles, Coffee, Mustard, Clorox Wipe Containers, etc.
- Glass Jars: All Colors, All Sizes.
- Tin Cans: Covers included, Rinsed clean (NO NEED TO REMOVE LABELS).
   Other items include; Aluminum Cat Food Cans, Aluminum Pie Plates, Cookie
   Tins and Tin Cans such as Juice Concentrate (NON-DEPOSIT), etc.
- **Waste Oil**: Used Motor Oil, (NO WATER OR ANTI-FREEZE). Anti-Freeze can be disposed of in hopper if converted into solid form using cat litter or speedy dry.
- Compost: Leaves, Grass Clippings, Garden Waste, Straw, Hay, etc. NOTE:
   Try to keep pile clean for reusing in gardens, (NO PLASTIC BAGS, OIL CONTAINERS, PESTICIDE BOTTLES, BRUSH OR WOOD).

#### OTHER ITEMS ACCEPTED AT THE TRANSFER STATION INCLUDE:

- Burn Pile: Brush, Lumber, Wooden Pallets, etc. (Pressure Treated Wood must be separated and disposed of separately). NO STUMPS OR LARGE DIAMETER WOOD WILL BE ACCEPTED.
  (See demo permit for building debris).
- Metal Pile: All Metal, Axles must have tires removed. Fuel Drums must be cut in half.
- Inert Fill: Porcelain Sinks and Toilets, Concrete Blocks, Bricks and Small-Rocks.
- Batteries: Vehicle Batteries, Motorcycle Batteries and Booster Packs.
   SEE ATTENDANT BEFORE UNLOADING ANY BATTERIES.

#### UNIVERSAL WASTE

- Televisions and Computer Monitors: SEE ATTENDANT.
- Fluorescent Lighting: Straight, Round, Energy Efficient Lighting (ALL SIZES).

#### ITEMS ALLOWED IN HOPPER

Bagged Garbage, Insulation, Sheetrock, Non-Recyclable Plastic, Vinyl Siding,
 Plate Glass such as what is found in windows and doors, and Canvas
 SEE ATTENDANT IF YOU ARE NOT SURE ABOUT AN ITEM.

NOTHING OVER 4' LONG WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE HOPPER
